Year 5 Sports Leaders

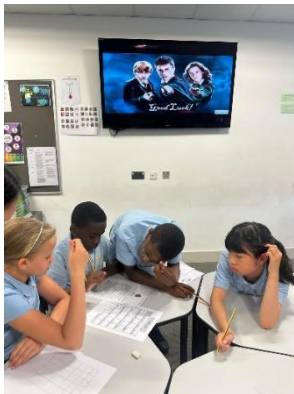

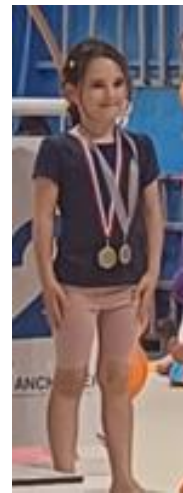
Nursery Graduation
