### St. Ann's Music Curriculum Overview

**LISTENING.** A programme of listening to understand musical development from Renaissance to the modern day will be taught with a whole school approach through hymn practice and Mass times when music will be played with historical fact displayed on the hall screen. This will be briefly explained during hymn practice and the music hall display will reinforce the factual information. Links will also be made to the history of art on the hall display board and powerpoint presentation.

#### Plan:

Autumn Term – Renaissance and Baroque (Monteverdi choral music, Vivaldi – Four seasons, Bach Christmas music)

History of Pop music through Autumn 1 singing programme and pop concert.

Spring term – Classical and Romantic (Beethoven, Mozart and Haydn; Mendelssohn – Fingal's Cave, Grieg – Peer Gynt Suite, Elgar)

Summer Term - Contemporary Music (Philip Glass, Schoenberg, Lutoslawski, Einaudi)

Music Technology – Garage Band using Ipads – mainly taught when the hall is unavailable with a longer topic during SATS in the summer term. (This programme is currently being developed)
